- **Lamp Recycling** — Waste Management's network of services includes close working relationships with lamp recycling specialists for your lamp management needs. Lamp recycling includes:
 - Fluorescent lamps (4' to 8')
 - Shielded lamps
 - HID lamps
 - Incandescent bulbs
 - Flood lamps
 - Neon lamps
 - UV lamps
 - Sodium lamps
- **Ballast and Electrical Equipment** — Through its quality subcontractors, Waste Management can provide safe collection and disposal of most ballast and electrical equipment, even those containing hazardous materials such as PCBs, including:
 - Fluorescent light ballast (PCB)
 - Fluorescent light ballast (non-PCB)
 - Mercury switches
 - Phone relays
