Pine Bluff Landfill

Serving North Atlanta Metro and northern Georgia, Pine Bluff Landfill provides local businesses and industries with professional disposal services that are safe, convenient and meet the highest standards for environmental compliance.

Containment Design

Pine Bluff Landfill utilizes a Subtitle D liner.

Leachate Collection & Treatment

Leachate is continuously collected and transported to a Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW).

Groundwater Monitoring

A detailed network of groundwater wells is used to monitor groundwater quality around the perimeter of the landfill. Groundwater is sampled regularly and tested for hazardous constituents. Results are reviewed for statistically significant increases.

Landfill Gas

Biologically produced gas, created by the decomposition of waste, produces a sustainable source of energy. This gas is extracted from the landfill and routed to our joint venture partner, Ameresco. The gas is sold as a substitute for natural gas to an industrial user located near the landfill.

Security

Access to the Pine Bluff Landfill is limited by fencing and natural barriers. Entrances and transactions are monitored by video surveillance.

Pine Bluff Landfill does not accept the following wastes:

- Batteries
- Hazardous waste
- Paint
- Tires
- Untreated biomedical waste

Industrial Waste Disposal - Waste Management provides the highest level of industrial and special waste services backed with a written indemnification that protects customers from fines, lawsuits, sanctions or other legal/regulatory actions.



Additional Site Information

Recycling - We provide an onsite collection bin for citizens to drop off recyclables.

Waste Receipt Standard - Waste Management has a defined waste screening protocol for each of its Subtitle D non-hazardous waste facilities. This waste screening procedure is used to protect both our employees and the environment. For all industrial and special waste streams, the generator or his/her agent must complete a Generator's Non-Hazardous Waste Profile (available online at www.WMDisposal.com) for review by our technical review staff. Oftentimes, the profile must be accompanied by analyses, MSDS, or other pertinent information. Manifests or Waste Shipment Records must generally accompany the waste shipment.
