Containment Design

Earlier landfill phases were constructed before Subtitle D regulations were established and utilize either low-permeability soil liners or 60 mil HDPE (High Density Polyethylene) geo-membranes. All later phases, up to and including Phase 4E, are Subtitle D-compliant.

Leachate Collection & Treatment

The leachate collection system is designed with a gravity drain system that filters media to the leachate sump. From there, liquid is pumped to two 20,000 gallon tanks and is hauled off site to the City of Topeka Waste Water Treatment Plant or is re-circulated back into the landfill.

Groundwater Monitoring

The landfill's groundwater monitoring systems consists of eight up-gradient and five down-gradient wells, each of which is sampled semi-annually.

Gas Management

Currently the landfill gas produced as Rolling Meadows is burned off with a LFG flare. A landfill gas-to-energy project is currently in development and is scheduled to go on-line in 2009. This facility will start with six engines and generate 4.8 megawatts of electricity, generating enough electricity to power 4,000 homes.

Security

Site security consists of perimeter fencing and a padlocked gate. There are security alarms in the scale house and maintenance shop as well as security cameras in and around the scale house.

Manifests or Waste Shipment Records must generally accompany the waste shipments, and can be provided to you upon approval of the waste stream.
