Waste Management's approximately 300 disposal facilities employ the latest advances in landfill technology. From carefully selecting new landfill locations to installing state-of-the-art liners to expertly capping landfills that have been filled to capacity, Waste Management makes every effort to ensure its sites' operational integrity as well as the safety of surrounding ecosystems. Spruce Ridge Landfill

Serving the western Minneapolis metro area, Spruce Ridge Landfill provides local businesses and industries with professional disposal services that are safe, convenient and meet the highest standards for environmental compliance.



Containment Design

At Spruce Ridge Landfill, containment is provided by a composite liner with two feet of compacted clay and a 60mil HDPE (High Density Polyethylene) liner.

Leachate Collection & Treatment

Spruce Ridge employs a standard EPA Subtitle D leachate collection system and also re-circulates leachate throughout portions of the landfill to encourage biorecovery.

Groundwater Monitoring

Spruce Ridge Landfill maintains 17 groundwater monitoring wells that are sampled three times per year.

Gas Management

Landfill gas is actively extracted via piping throughout the landfill and piped to a gas-to-energy plant, which is then sold to the Glencoe Utility Company. Enough electricity is generated to power approximately 500 homes.

Security

The entire facility is fenced. There is also a security system in place that is monitored 24/7.

Next Generation (Bioreactor)

Off-spec liquids and sludges are taken to a designated bioreactor MSW cell that has been specifically permitted and is managed for this purpose.

Industrial Waste Disposal - Waste Management provides the highest level of industrial and special waste services backed with a written indemnification that protects customers from fines, lawsuits, sanctions or other legal/regulatory actions.

Next Generation Technology - Spruce Ridge is a "Next Generation" landfill in that it employs specially engineered and managed microorganisms to rapidly break down organic wastes. Having this technology allows Spruce Ridge to accept off-spec liquids and sludges as they provide an excellent medium for these helpful microbes.

Recycling - We offer on site recycling of cardboard, paper, glass, and cans as well as used appliances, electronics and tires.

Transportation Services - Waste Management has a defined waste screening protocol for each of its Subtitle D facilities. This waste screening procedure is used to protect our employees, neighbors, and our environment. For all industrial and special waste streams, the generator or agent must complete a Generator's Non-Hazardous Waste Profile (available online at www.WMDisposal.com) for review by our technical staff. Often times, the profile must be accompanied by analysis, MSDS or other pertinent information. Manifests or Waste Shipment Records must generally accompany the waste shipments, and can be provided to you upon approval of the waste stream.
