Gray Wolf Regional Landfill is a regional facility that provides safe and convenient disposal services for communities, businesses and industries serving Yavapai County and Northern Arizona.

Leachate Collection & Treatment

The leachate collection and removal system at Gray Wolf currently includes four monitored collection sumps with automatic evacuation pumps. Leachate is collected and managed in double-lined evaporation ponds. The system consists of a highly permeable gravel drainage layer that covers the entire landfill base.

Security

Site security is ensured by controlled, limited access to the facility as well as perimeter fencing and electronic surveillance. The facility can only be accessed via a single gate, which directs all traffic to a gatehouse occupied during business hours by trained personnel. During non-business hours, the gate is locked and monitored by electronic surveillance.

Approval Process

Waste Management has a defined waste screening protocol for each of its non-hazardous waste facilities, which protects employees and the environment. For industrial and special waste streams, the generator or agent must complete a waste profile for review by our technical staff. Waste profiles can be completed online at WMSolutions.com. Gray Wolf Landfill requires a 24-hour prior approval for special waste loads.

WASTE MANAGEMENT

Acceptable Material

- Asbestos – Non-Friable
- Ash
- Construction & Demolition (C&D) Debris
- Exploration & Production Wastes (E&P)
- Industrial Waste
- Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)

*e.g. any discarded material that, due to its physical or chemical characteristics, requires more stringent handling, documentation or other management than normal Municipal Solid Waste (MSW).

Unacceptable Material

- Asbestos – Friable
- Auto Shredder Fluff
- Biohazardous Medical Waste
- Bulk or non-containerized liquid waste as defined in 40 CFR 258.28(c)(1) including containers with more than 2% of the original liquid volume or free liquids as defined in EPA Method 9095 (paint filter test) except as authorized pursuant to MFPA Section 3.3 (liquid solidification)
- Burning Materials for direct landfill without extinguishing
- CESQG [Hazardous] Wastes
- CFC (Freon) Containing Items
- Explosives
- Hazardous Waste

- Off-Spec Products
- Paint Wastes
- Process Waste
- Special Wastes*
- Yard Waste

- Incompatible wastes (e.g. incompatible to be comingled with MSW)
- NORM/TeNORM with radionuclides >5 pCi/g
- PCB waste except as allowed under 40 CFR 761.61 (PCB Remediation Waste), 40 CFR 761.62 (PCB Bulk Product Waste) and 40 CFR 761.63 (PCB Household waste)
- Universal Waste
- Used Oil (as defined in 40 CFR 279)
- Waste Tires
- Any other waste prohibited from disposal at any municipal solid waste landfill by federal, state, or local statute or regulation
