

Alaska Street Reload and Transfer Station

The Alaska Street Reload and Transfer Station serves industrial customers throughout Puget Sound, providing safe, cost-effective, and environmentally sound management solutions for non-hazardous material, as well as special, highly regulated services for hazardous waste. This site accepts and transfers material received from industrial customers only.

The Alaska Street facility is centrally located in Seattle and offers rail access for direct transport to Waste Management's Columbia Ridge facility in Eastern Oregon. The facility's location and rail connection provide unique economic benefits and convenience for customers including lower fuel expenses and reduced haul time.

10-Day Transfer Facility

As a special service for commercial customers who require management of hazardous drums in a safe and professional manner, Waste Management operates a highly regulated 10-Day Transfer Facility at Alaska Street Transfer Station. The facility is permitted to hold hazardous drums for a period of not more than 10 days before shipping to a hazardous waste facility.

Environmental Controls

This site is engineered with environmental protection systems to meet or exceed stringent local, state and federal requirements. Our outstanding compliance record illustrates our commitment to meeting industry and community needs, while protecting public health and the environment.

The Alaska Street facility includes an indoor unloading area to safely contain material on-site and to ensure safety and convenience for our customers, regardless of the weather. Additionally, all non-hazardous material is unloaded onto a concrete pad and then loaded into rail cars. A high-pressure wheel wash avoids tracking of material onto city streets.

Security

A single access point and total perimeter fencing ensure reliable security for this site.
