

American Landfill

American Landfill is a regional facility that provides safe and convenient disposal services for communities, businesses and industries serving Stark County and surrounding areas.

Waste Management's approximately 300 disposal facilities employ the latest advances in landfill technology. This facility is engineered with environmental protection systems that meet or exceed rigorous government regulations and are subject to highly regulated monitoring and reporting requirements. Systems include engineered liners and covers, leachate collection and removal, and landfill gas collection and control.

Containment Design

American Landfill utilizes a double-layer, 3-foot clay and a 60 mil geomembrane liner system to ensure that waste and wastewater (leachate) are contained and isolated from soil and groundwater.

Leachate Collection & Treatment

Leachate is managed onsite via recirculation, as well as, hauled by truck to the Canton City Water Reclamation Facility.

Groundwater Monitoring

Groundwater is monitored at 40 wells, which are upgradient and downgradient of the waste disposal footprint. The groundwater monitoring network is sampled and analyzed semi-annually in accordance with the procedures of the facility's groundwater sampling and analysis plan.

Landfill Gas Management

American Landfill collects and manages landfill gas through an extensive gas collection system with 155 wells, which reduces emissions and minimizes odor. The landfill gas is then processed and converted to a high-BTU gas and sent to Dominion East Ohio.

Security

Site security is ensured by controlled, limited access to the facility through the gatehouse as well as perimeter fencing and natural barriers. During non-business hours this facility is monitored by 24-hour electronic surveillance.
