## Voyageur Landfill

Voyageur Landfill is an industrial and demolition landfill that provides a safe and convenient disposal location for the community and the surrounding area. It is in Northern Minnesota in the town of Canyon, Minnesota.

Voyageur Landfill has a permitted capacity for Industrial waste of 4,478,157 cubic yards and a permitted capacity for demolition debris of 344,540 cubic yards.

## Containment Design

The area of Voyageur Landfill permitted for industrial waste utilizes a composite liner system consisting of compacted clay, geosynthetic clay, a 60 mil geomembrane and a one foot thick leachate drainage layer to ensure waste and wastewater (leachate) are contained and isolated from soil and groundwater.

## Leachate Collection & Treatment

Leachate is managed onsite via 2 storage tanks and hauled by truck to WLSSD Scanlon Wastewater Treatment Facility.

## Groundwater Monitoring

Groundwater is monitored at 9 wells, which are upgradient, side-gradient and downgradient of the waste disposal footprint. The groundwater monitoring network is sampled and analyzed semi-annually in accordance with the procedures of the facility's ground water sampling and analysis plan.
